
What is DVS?

The **Direct Vision Standard** is a new safety legislation from Transport for London. From 1st March 2021, HGVs over 12T will need a Safety Permit to enter Greater London. Visit **tfl.gov.uk** for more info.


How does it work?

Direct Vision Standard (DVS) measures a driver's vision through the windows of an HGV Cab. A star rating system from zero (limited vision) to five (increased vision) is used to indicate the level of risk to people walking and cycling near the vehicle.

Star rating system

0 star-rated vehicles with an approved Safe System will be granted a permit until 2024.

2 ★ ★ ☆ ☆ ☆ 1 and 2 star-rated vehicles will be granted permits until 2024.

4 ★ ★ ★ ☆ ☆ 3,4 and 5 star-rated vehicles will be granted a 10-year permit.

When?

October 2020: Apply for permit.

0-star vehicles need a Safe System to apply.1 - 5 star vehicles can apply.

March 1st 2021: Law comes into effect.

0-star HGVs without Safe System will be banned. HGVs without permit entering Greater London will be fined.
